Privacy Policy

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LocalPaper.com LLC a Delaware corporation doing business as "LocalPaper" brings together prospective investors and borrowers ("Borrowers") seeking capital and or loans ("Loans"). On this website (the "Portal") lenders can post opportunities of Borrowers seeking loans. Whether you are a prospective investor, Borrower seeking a Loan, casual visitor or registered user of the Portal, your use of the Portal is governed by this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy describes how LocalPaper.com, LLC ("LocalPaper", "we," "us," or "our") collects, uses, shares, and protects personal information. This Privacy Policy also tells you about your choices with respect to your personal information and how you can reach us to get answers to your questions.

Information We Collect

We collect information about you in a variety of ways depending on how you interact with us and our websites and services, including:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us, such as when you register for an account, sign up to receive communications from us, or contact us by phone, email, or otherwise.
- Automatically through the use of cookies, server logs, and other similar technologies when you interact with our websites, advertisement and emails.
- From other sources, including, for example, our affiliates, business partners, service providers, and other third parties, or from publicly available sources. For example, if you engage in a transaction with a Borrower seeking a Loan on the Portal, information from third-party data sources may be gathered by LocalPaper, its vendors and the issuers of securities for the purposes of legal compliance, due diligence and to complete the transaction.

The following chart provides examples of the type of information that we collect in a variety of contexts and how we use that information.

Cookies and Similar Tracking Technologies	We use cookies and similar technologies We use cookies and similar tracking technologies, including pixel tags or web beacons (collectively "cookies "), to collect certain information when you interact with our websites and email communications. We also permit certain third parties to use cookies and similar tracking technologies to collect information about your use of our websites. The information collected by these tracking technologies may include (a) your internet protocol (IP) address, unique device identifiers, location, browser type, and Internet service provider information; (b) information about when and how you access and use our websites, such as the domains you visit, what features you used and for how long, the website that referred you to us, and date/time stamps associated with your usage; (c) information about the device you use to access the websites, such as device type, device ID, and device/browser settings; and (d) location of the device used to access the websites. Website Interactions	We use technology to monitor how you interact with our website. This may include which links you click on, or information that you type into our online forms. This may also include information about your device or browser.	To understand how you interact with our website to better improve it, and to understand your preferences and interests in order to select offerings that you might find most useful. We also use this information to detect and prevent against fraud.
Web Logs	We collect information, including your browser type, operating system, Internet Protocol (IP) address (a number that is automatically assigned to a computer when the internet is used), domain name, click-activity, referring website, and/or a date/time stamp for visitors.	To monitor our networks and the visitors to our websites. Among other things, it helps us understand which of our services is the most popular.

How We Use Information

In addition to the purposes and uses described above, we use personal information in the following ways:

- To operate our websites.
- To improve our websites, services, and offerings.
- To conduct analytics.
- To communicate with you, such as to respond to and/or follow-up on your requests, inquiries, issues, or feedback.
- To send information, marketing and/or promotional materials.
- To detect and protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity, including violation of our policies and terms and conditions, security incidents, and harm to the rights, property, or safety of our company and our users, employees, or others.
- To debug, identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality of our website and services.

- To comply with our legal or regulatory obligations, to establish or exercise our rights, and to defend against a legal claim.
- For internal administrative purposes, as well as to manage our relationships.
- For such other purposes as you may consent (from time to time).

How We Share Information

In addition to the specific situations discussed elsewhere in this Privacy Policy, we may disclose personal information in the following situations:

- Affiliates and Partners. We may share information with our corporate affiliates (*e.g.*, parent company, sister companies, subsidiaries, joint ventures, or other companies under common control) and our partners.
- **Business Transactions**. If another company acquires, or plans to acquire, our company, business, or our assets, we will also share information with that company, including at the negotiation stage.
- Other Disclosures without Your Consent. We may disclose information in response to subpoenas, warrants, or court orders, or in connection with any legal process, or to comply with relevant laws. We may also share your information in order to establish or exercise our rights, to defend against a legal claim, to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding possible illegal activities, suspected fraud, safety of person or property, or a violation of our policies.
- Service Providers. We may share your information with to companies that provide services to help us with our business activities such as broker-dealer oversight, Accredited Investor Verification, Anti-Money Laundering and Know Your Customer reviews, payment processing, and offering customer service.
- Other Disclosures with Your Consent. We may disclose your information to other third parties when we have your consent or direction to do so.
- **Public**. Our website offers publicly accessible comment pages and forums. You should be aware that any information you provide in these areas may be viewed, read, collected, and used by others. Any information that you post to public areas of the Portal will, of course, be accessible to the public and due to the nature and technology of the Internet will continue to be available even after you delete the information from public posting.

Cookies and Similar Tracking Technologies

We use a variety of technologies such as cookies, web beacons, clear GIF, pixels, internet tags, and browser/web logs to gather information when you visit or interact with our websites and email communications. We use this information for a variety of purposes, such as to make our websites work properly, to make a user's experience more efficient, to understand how visitors interact with our websites, and to for advertising purposes.

The following explains the types of cookies we use and why:

• **Necessary and Functional**. Some technology is needed for the operation of our website. This includes cookies that enable basic functions such as page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. Because our website cannot function properly without this technology, it is always

active. Note that while you can set your browser to block this type of technology, doing so may cause some parts of our websites to not work.

- Analytics. Analytics technologies are primarily used to improve our products, services, and user experiences, including the operation and layout of our website. Analytics may be conducted by us or one of our service providers. For example, we use Google Analytics on our websites to collect usage data, to analyze how users use the web sites and to provide advertisements to you on other websites. Some tracking is used to collect information about how you use our website, such as which pages you visit, how often you visit, and where you are visiting from. - Advertising. Advertising tracking technology, such as behavioral advertising cookies, may be set by us, or by third parties. This means that a third party uses technology (*e.g.*, a cookie) to collect information about your use of our website so that they can report analytics to us or provide advertising about products and services tailored to your interests. That third party might also collect information over time and across different websites in order to serve advertisements on our website or other websites.

Your Choices

You can make the following choices regarding your personal information:

You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your password, and you are responsible for any access to or use of your account by someone else that has obtained your password, whether or not such access or use has been authorized by you.
